## What is Assistive Technology?

Assistive Technology is the tools and resources used by individuals with disabilities to help increase independence and improve quality of life. AT comes in many shapes and forms. It helps people in education, employment, home, and community settings.

AT may include:

- Modified computers
- Walkers, scooters, and wheelchairs
- Communication boards
- Personal care devices
- Remote controls for lights and appliances
- Adapted recreational equipment
- Home and worksite modifications
- Adapted vans and vehicles
- Ramps and grab bars
- Hearing aids
- Braille equipment
- Print enlargers

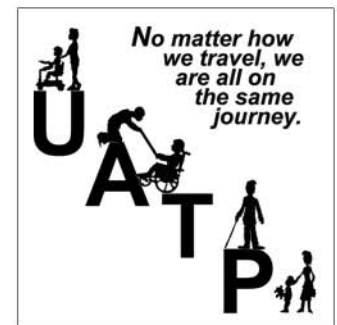

Provides assistive technology training, services, and research for and with individuals in the community, students, and professionals throughout the state of Utah.



### AT Laboratory Services

- Device demonstration and equipment lending
- Training on construction of simple, low-cost assistive devices
- Maintenance and repair of assistive technologies
- Development of prototype devices
- Wheelchair evaluation
- Training on adaptive computer technologies

Utah has a statewide network of assistive technology lending and recycling programs located throughout the state. UATP will refer you to the program nearest you.

### Utah Assistive Technology Foundation (UATF)

Low-interest loans from \$500 to \$50,000 to buy assistive technology devices for qualified Utah residents of any age with disabilities.



### Access to TeleWork

Zero-interest loans (\$7,000 maximum for working Utahns with disabilities to purchase equipment to work from home or a telework center.

Examples of eligible equipment:

- Computers
- Video conferencing devices
- Worksite modifications
