What is Assistive Technology?

Assistive technology is any item, piece of equipment, or product system, whether acquired commercially off the shelf, modified, or customized, that is used to increase, maintain, or improve functional capabilities of individuals with disabilities. Simply stated, AT are tools and resources used by individuals with disabilities to help improve their quality of life and increase their independence.

Assistive Technology includes:

- Wheelchairs, scooters, walkers
- Modified computers
- Personal care devices
- Braille equipment
- Adapted vans and vehicles
- Communication devices including iPads
- Hearing Aids
- Adapted recreational equipment
- Home modifications
